With so much to do, don't forget the Reading Time !

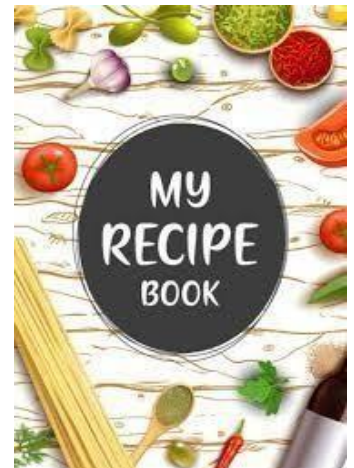
Spend the afternoon with a great book and you will surely lead the class !

1. Kitchen survey

● BIT BY BIT ORBIT

The Earth takes 365 days to go around the Sun. The other planets also orbit around the Sun. Calculate the time taken by them using the clues given below to complete the table.

Planet	Mercury	Venus	Earth	Mars	Jupiter	Saturn	Uranus	Neptune
No. of Earth days to go around the Sun			365	687		10759		60190

● CLUES:

1. Venus takes 140 Earth days less than Earth to go around the sun.
2. Jupiter takes 3,646 Earth days more than Mars to go around the sun.
3. Uranus journeys around the sun for 19,928 Earth days more than Saturn.
4. Mercury and Neptune together journey around the sun for 60,278 Earth days.

● HUNGRY FAMILY

1. Planet with a 5 in its ten's place gets a pizza.
2. The planet whose one period has 190 gets a burger.
3. The planet with days that expand to $300+60+5$ gets lemonade.
4. The planet with days that take only 2 places gets noodles.
5. The predecessor of this planet is 30,686 and it gets a cake.
